Thank you for choosing Captain Rick's Diving Adventure for your NAUI Scuba Diver certification. I am sure that you have several questions on the process of getting certified. Hopefully this will answer most of them.

Registering for your class is your first step toward your certification. Simply call Captain Rick's Diving Adventure at 614-948-3481 to register.

Your next step is to schedule a time to come into the dive shop, get an orientation, and fill out the required registration forms. You should plan to be there about 3 hours. During the orientation, you will learn about the dive gear, its use, and features. You will also learn how to correctly assemble, and disassemble it. Don't worry, you will get the chance to do this several times.

There are three steps to getting your certification.

Academics

The first step is your curriculum piece of it. You can learn either in the traditional classroom setting, or in the newer online method we refer to as eLearning. The cost is the same, but two different approaches. Both options include a text book, as well as a workbook.



eLearning

If you choose the eLearning method, you will register with NAUI through a link on our website. Simply go www.CaptainRicksScuba.com and scroll down until you see the link for NAUI eLearning. This link will take you to the NAUI website where you will register. You will need to enter your "activation code" that is found on the inside cover of your Scuba Diver book. You will need to enter a "NAUI Trainer Number"

of your choice:

You will also need to enter a "NAUI Store Number" of CAP01554 (note that after the letter "P" is a "Zero"). With the eLearning, you will complete all nine chapters, each having a quiz. After all nine chapters are completed, you will take a final test. If you have ANY questions during the eLearning class, you are always welcome to get further help from one of our instructors. If multiple people are using the same computer for the eLearning, it is helpful for the current user to "log out" before the next user attempts to "log in". If you cannot view the pages correctly, you may want to try another browser. NAUI eLearning can also be used from an iPad or a Tablet. Once you have completed the eLearning course, please print out the certificate that states you have completed the eLearning course.
